MEDICINE



Cottonwood Veterinary Clinic has diagnostic equipment and laboratory services to diagnose and treat medical conditions and illnesses that can develop in companion animals.

RADIOLOGY • ULTRASOUND

We have an X-ray machine and processor on site. Cottonwood also provides small animal ultrasound services which broadens our diagnostic capabilities.

SURGERY • ANESTHESIA

From routine surgery to complicated orthopedic procedures, our well-equipped clinic can provide on-site care. Cottonwood Vet Clinic takes extensive precautions and provides the best combination for each animal in order to ensure a safe, rapid and painless recovery. We also monitor the patient's pulse, blood oxygen levels and blood pressure with the best available equipment during anesthesia.

DENTAL • VISUAL

The staff at Cottonwood will be happy to suggest brushing kits, toothpaste or special chew treats to

reduce tartar and plaque build up that leads to tooth and bone loss. For more advanced cases, ultrasonic cleaning and polishing are also available. Our staff is also skilled in the diagnosis and treatment of eye diseases and injuries.



KNOWLEDGE

Our veterinarians are dedicated to having the most advanced treatment options available. In addition to continuing education classes and attendance at veterinary conferences, Cottonwood subscribes to the Veterinary Information Network, an online web site that allows conferencing with doctors across the nation. Our close working relationship with veterinary colleagues at Kansas State, Iowa State and Colorado State Universities offers more opportunities to consult with clinicians and refer patients to their specialists if necessary.

ALLERGY • DERMATOLOGY



Allergies have become a wide spread problem in both humans and animals. Food and environmental allergies create problems for pets. We can diagnose and prescribe medications that will provide relief. Bathing treatment is another method of controlling some allergies and skin problems. Dandruff, oily hair coat and ear infections are a few conditions that can be controlled by regular cleansing treatments.

MICROCHIP

We offer micro-chipping to permanently identify your pets. The I.D. can be registered with a national record keeping system in case your pet gets lost and is taken to a shelter or clinic.

PHYSICAL THERAPY

We perform physical therapy evaluations for pets that may need additional help to recover from injuries and orthopedic surgeries. Exercise equipment and therapeutic ultrasound aid in the rehabilitation process, which may continue with exercises in the home.

BEHAVIOR • OBEDIENCE

Cottonwood can help your pet can be the family member you've always wanted. Puppies who



attend our Puppy Preschool are happy and well-socialized. Periodically, we offer full obedience training for dogs and CVC provides in-depth consultations for more unpleasant behaviors such as house soiling, nuisance barking or aggressive behavior.

BOARDING • DAYCARE

Need a place for your pet to stay while you're away? Cottonwood Vet Clinic give your pet his own hotel space, meals and treats for a day, overnight or even longer. Dogs have playtime and toys in the fenced backyard. Cats lounge in their condo with a view of dogs at play. Baths can be given if requested. Nutritional consultations are also available.
